Depending on the characteristics of your space and your preferences, we will advise you, for FREE, on what set of tools and products are best to be used in your home in order to have a better cleaning experience. We tested and trust all these tools and products presented below.

What Cleaning Tools do I need?

- **Full-sized vacuum cleaner** – with filter bags, if applicable. A handheld vacuum does not count – vacuums help remove dust and allergens in your home.
- **Flat head mop (system)** – best used for hardwood and laminate floors. Some clients prefer this mop style for ease storage.
- **Microfiber twist mop & wringer bucket** - these mops offer a superior clean for tile, vinyl and linoleum floors.
- **Heavy-duty two sided sponges** – one for bathrooms and one for the kitchen (*we recommend eco-friendly*).
- **Microfiber cloth** – we recommend to use microfiber tools in cleaning for their antibacterial and antimicrobial properties, and superior cleaning effect. They do not scratch surfaces and do not leave traces. We will advise you on how to clean your microfiber cloths.
- **Spray bottles** – that way we can mix up solutions as required, especially if you prefer us to use natural products (for example vinegar).
- **Toilet bowl brush** with a bowl brush container.
- **Paper towel** – used on surfaces where we do not clean with cloths, for toilet seats for example.
- **Squeegee** – one for glass showers (optional) and one for all windows. We recommend a two sided squeegee with microfiber and rubber sides.

- **Step ladder** (optional) – for higher areas (windows).
- **Small brush** - allows to get the smaller nooks.

What Cleaning Products do I need?

- **White vinegar** - a natural amazingly efficient product when it comes to antibacterial degreasing effects.
- **Baking soda** – very efficient in providing gentle abrasion where other cleaners cannot be used, is an efficient deodorizer.
- **(Eco) glass cleaner** – for mirrors and windows. We recommend to use white vinegar and plain water mixed in a spray bottle;
- **Dish soap or black all purpose soap** – a pH neutral used for several parts of the home which require a mild cleaner.
- **Other “ready to use” products** that you might prefer to use, like: all-purpose and abrasive cleaners and disinfectants. We recommend you to choose eco-friendly product lines.
